# STAR WARS

Come along with Tidbits as we reminisce over "Star Wars"!

### STAR WARS FACTS

- George Lucas was the genius behind "Star Wars." His success with "American Graffiti" in 1973 earned him the backing of 20th Century Fox, which put up the money to turn out the first Star Wars film. The movie was four years in the making, with scenes being shot in Tunisia, Death Valley, California, and on sound stages in England. It was released in May of 1977, initially showing up in only 42 theaters across the U.S. It earned \$3 million in its first week and had grossed \$100 million by the end of the summer.
- The film, initially entitled simply "Star Wars," eventually spawned a trilogy of trilogies released at intervals over the next 42 years. Afterwards, the original film was re-named "Star Wars: A New Hope."
- The famous floating text that opens the movie "A long time ago in a galaxy far, far away" was filmed by placing 2-foot-wide die cut yellow letters over a 6-foot-long black paper background with a camera making a slow pass over the top of them to mimic the crawl. The entire process took

• If you're able to, fold and hang clothing straight from the dryer. The warmth of a cycle can set wrinkles that occur from being stuffed into a laundry basket.



**The Garden Bug**

**Ferns** generally prefer soil that is more acidic than alkaline, with lots of decaying organic matter and filtered light. Ferns prefer a highly moist environment, such as in a wetlands or along a water source, so if rain is infrequent in your area, try to induce wet conditions in your garden by watering enough to keep the top 6 inches of soil moist but not soggy.



three hours.

Darth Vader only appears for 12 minutes of screen time but is one of the most instantly recognizable villains of all time.

Darth Vader was played by four men. The on-screen body of Vader was bodybuilder David Prowse; the stunt double was professional fencer Bob Anderson; the voice was James Earl Jones; and the de-helmeted face of Vader in "Return of The Jedi" was Sebastian Shaw.

David Prowse's Bristol accent was inappropriate for a master villain. George Lucas wanted Orson Welles as the voice of Darth Vader, but dropped the idea because he thought Welles' voice was too recognizable.

They initially wanted a well-known movie star like Laurence Olivier or John Gielgud to be the face that is revealed behind the mask, but later thought it'd be better if Vader turned out to be a nondescript person. Stage actor Sebastian Shaw was not a widely known face.

David Prowse turned down the role of Chewbacca. When given the choice between portraying the two characters, Prowse said, "I turned down the role of Chewbacca at once. I know that people remember villains longer than heroes. At the time I didn't know I'd be wearing a mask, and throughout production I thought Vader's voice would be mine."

James Earl Jones was so sure the film would be a flop that he refused to allow his name to be published on the original credits.

A big hint that Darth Vader is Luke's father comes from the fact that the Dutch word for "father" is "vader."

The original Chewbacca costume was made using real yak and rabbit hair, hand knitted into a base of mohair from Angora goats. It was very hot, so when a new costume was created for "Revenge of the Sith," a water-cooling system was included. This costume was only used for one day of shooting.

Peter Mayhew was chosen to play Chewbacca because of his tremendous height: He was 7 feet 3 inches tall. Mayhew was working as an orderly at a hospital when he was cast.

Although Chewbacca was more animal than human, the studio execs weren't happy about the fact the Wookiee was essentially naked. Sketches were submitted depicting the Wookiee wearing lederhosen, culottes, and baggy shorts. The plan was scrapped.

Yoda was originally supposed to be portrayed by a real monkey wearing a mask. Fortunately, a monkey expert who had worked with apes for the movie "2001: A Space Odyssey" pointed out, "Look, the monkey's just going to pull off the mask over and over again. It's never going to





### Good Housekeeping

#### Baked Ricotta With Vinaigrette

This recipe is perfect for a first course at your Easter table.

- 2 lemons
- 32 ounces part-skim ricotta cheese
- Salt and pepper
- 1/2 teaspoons Dijon mustard
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 4 tomatoes
- 1 bag baby greens

- Heat oven to 375 F. From lemons, grate 1 teaspoon peel and squeeze 3 tablespoons juice. Set aside. Spray 9-inch glass or ceramic pie plate with nonstick cooking spray.
- In medium bowl, stir lemon peel, ricotta, 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper until blended. Spread ricotta mixture evenly in prepared pie plate. Bake 1 hour or until cheese is lightly browned. Let stand 10 minutes to allow cheese to set. Slice into 12 wedges.
- Meanwhile, in medium bowl, whisk together lemon juice, Dijon, 1/4 teaspoon salt, and 1/8 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper. Whisk in olive oil in slow steady stream until blended. Stir in chopped tomatoes.





THE HISTORY CHANNEL

- On April 11, 1814, Napoleon Bonaparte, emperor of France, abdicates the throne and is banished to the Mediterranean island of Elba. Napoleon is credited with reforms that had a lasting impact on European society, including rights for all men and the end of feudalism.



• While taking a train trip, the young Dr. Frankenstein hears a couple bickering, in English. Later the same couple is bickering, having the same argument word-for-word, but in German.

• Gene Hackman, who regularly played tennis with Gene Wilder, found out about the film and begged for a part because he'd never done comedy before. A special scene was written just for him, where he plays a blind character serving soup to Frankenstein's monster and spilling it in his lap, then commenting: "I was going to make espresso...." The cameo was uncredited and Gene Hackman is all but unrecognizable in the scene.

• Peter Boyle, who played the monster, met his wife when she showed up on set to write an article about the film.

• Marty Feldman played the hunchback Igor. He wore a fake hump and kept switching it from one shoulder to the next just to see how long it would take someone to notice. When one of the crew finally did notice days later, the gag was written into the script, leading to the memorable line, "What hump?"

• Marty Feldman as Igor also improvised the line, "Walk this way" as he limped away. Steven Tyler of Aerosmith saw the film and loved the gag. He was inspired to write the song "Walk This Way" for his next album.

• It was Marty Feldman's first Hollywood movie.

• Madeline Kahn was originally supposed to play the role of Inga, the lab assistant, while Teri Garr was cast as Elizabeth, the high-tone fiancé. Kahn decided she preferred the other role, so Mel Brooks called Teri Garr into his office and said, "If you can come back tomorrow with a German accent, the part is yours." Garr responded, "Vell, yes, I could do zee German ackzent tomorrow. I could come back zis afternoon!" Garr had appeared on "The Sonny and Cher Comedy Hour" several times in 1971, where the German hairdresser for the show had a heavy accent. Garr picked up the accent from her.

• Teri Garr's mother was the wardrobe mistress on the film.

• The clock chimes thirteen times at the beginning of the film when the coffin is opened.

• "Young Frankenstein" won 11 Oscars at the Academy Awards.

• Mel Brooks and Gene Wilder worked together on three wildly successful films including "The Producers" and "Blazing Saddles" but after "Young Frankenstein" they never found an opportunity to work together again.



### What Are the Benefits of Medical ID Tags?



DEAR DR. ROACH: My question is about medical bracelets and necklaces. I've never seen any recommendations as to what conditions would warrant wearing one nor what the inscription should say. When are they either necessary or beneficial? -- D.A.M.

ANSWER: Medical ID tags can be useful. They serve to alert medical personnel of potentially important medical conditions when someone is not capable of providing that information, whether due to temporary incapacity (such as being unconscious in a motor vehicle accident) or permanent disability (such as intellectual disability). In my opinion, the most appropriate use of these tags is when there is a potentially life-threatening medical condition that would not

be obvious to emergency medical personnel.

Some examples of these would include anaphylactic reaction to medications or latex; the presence of an illness that can cause temporary disability (epilepsy, diabetes, Addison's disease); and medical conditions that might affect use of some common treatments, such as bleeding disorders, organ transplant status and medical implants (such as implantable defibrillators). Personal and contact information is a natural set of complementary information to have on a medical tag.

Some newer tags include electronic information, but

this is in its infancy. These include the use of near-field technology to let emergency personnel read the information (if they also have the technology); phone numbers the emergency personnel can call to get more information; and QR codes to allow emergency personnel with a smartphone to go to a webpage with more detailed information. Most smartphones also have the ability to store information that can be read in an emergency, even by someone without the person's phone password. I recommend taking advantage of this feature.

Many of the ID tags I see have information that is not likely to be helpful. Listing chronic conditions like high blood pressure or high cholesterol is not necessary.

Finally, one of the biggest benefits of a medical ID tag is a little peace of mind.

### Blackball Box

Q: I have a light bulb that I have identified as an 1885 Heisler-Bernstein incandescent lamp. Does it have any value?

And if so, where would I find a buyer for such a bulb?

A: Antique and vintage light bulbs are classified as "early technology," an area of collecting that includes electrical apparatus, astronomical devices and medical instruments. Artificial lighting is significant, since its beginning in the 1880s marked the lengthening of the workday and other changes in everyday life.

Yes, there are collectors who hunt for early incandescent light bulbs, especially early carbon filament ones from the 1880s to early 1900s with intact filaments, like yours. Some early bulbs bring high prices; a few have sold for over \$5,000. Charles Heisler and Alexander Bernstein both owned businesses in the 1880s and early 1900s that developed bulbs and lamps, and their work was influential in making electric lighting practical and popular. Look for an auction house that specializes in early technology or scientific instruments. The website [www.bulbcollector.com](http://www.bulbcollector.com) also has information.

**TIP: If your tea caddy or knife box has a silver or brass keyhole, don't use a metal cleaner. The cleaner will damage the wood.**

An old blackball box used by the Odd Fellows fraternal order was sold at a Garth's auction recently for \$500.


